EXPANDING

REPEAT WHAT THE CHILD SAID BUT ADD 1 – 2 WORDS OF YOUR OWN

Eg Child: I went shopping Adult: You went shopping <u>yesterday</u> You and <u>mummy</u> went shopping You went shopping at<u>Tesco's</u>

USEFUL FOR:	 Children who are using shorter phrases that peers Quite/reluctant children Bilingual children
WHEN TO USE:	No particular activity, whenever a child speaks to you
HOW TO DO:	 Don't make it sound like you are correcting them – start with 'yes' or 'oh' Stress the words you are adding Add different types of words, eg verbs, nouns, adjectives For children using 4 or more word phrases you can add a whole phrase, eg 'Oh, you went shopping and you bought some bananas'
WHY USE IT:	 Encourages vocabulary and grammatical development Expanding gives the child a model of language structures which are one step further on in the development of their expressive language
