It is with deep sadness that we acknowledge the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Her Majesty was the longest serving British monarch in history, who dedicated her life to public service, setting an example for all of us. Our deepest sympathies go out to our new King and all members of the Royal Family at this very sad time.

In a statement, HM Lord-Lieutenant of Leicestershire, Michael Kapur OBE, said: “I am deeply saddened by the death of our Queen, who dedicated her life to the service of our country and the Commonwealth. Queen Elizabeth served as our Monarch longer than any of her predecessors and was hugely respected and loved by people across the world. The recent Platinum Jubilee celebrations demonstrated how loved and treasured she was.”

Many of you will want to give your condolences and there are several ways to do this. During the period of mourning, there will be no formal council meetings and we expect a small number of larger meetings will need to be rescheduled. You will be advised of which meetings will not take place in due course. Meetings with council officers will proceed as scheduled in order to ensure continuity of services.
