Healthy Pupils Capital Fund

In March the Department for Education (DfE) issued local authority allocations for the Healthy Pupils Capital Fund (HPCF).

The HPCF is intended to improve children's and young people's physical and mental health by improving and increasing availability to facilities for physical activity, healthy eating, mental health and wellbeing and medical conditions.

Direct allocations for HPCF will be made to bodies responsible for individual institutions:

Local authorities are responsible and receive funding for community, foundation and voluntary controlled schools.

Voluntary aided schools are notionally assigned to their local authority. The local authority will coordinate the administration of their group funding allocation through the Locally Coordinated Voluntary Aided Programme (LCVAP).

Multi-academy trusts with five or more academies and at least 3,000 pupils receive a funding allocation for their academies. Where an academy chain has opted-in to receive a School Condition Allocation, they will also receive a direct allocation for HPCF.

For local authority maintained schools the allocation is £202,062. This has been allocated to schools maintained by the authority at 1/4/2018 of £2,223 per school with an allocation of £1,000 per maintained nurse schools. The list of schools and allocations are shown below.

The grant is allocated and must be used in 2018/19 and the full terms and conditions governing the use of the grant can be seen on the following link:

The local authority will require that each receiving school confirms that the grant has been used for its intended purpose at the end of the 2018/19 financial year.

Public Health have made the following suggestion for the use of the grant which link into current initiatives;

- Additional service hot counters to support queue reduction
- Transport costs to farms, or to cover the costs of a visit from a food producer
- Cooking equipment. An increased number of cooking sessions can be delivered where there are multiple cooking equipment sets.
- Start-up costs for initiatives such as fruit snack shops, Funding for Plate and bowls.
