Although Leicestershire schools are below the national average for the amount of exclusions of young people with ASD we are committed to working hard to reduce this number further. Too many young people with ASD are sent home early, excluded, on part time timetables or working in isolation within their schools. Autism Outreach Service and the National Autistic Society are putting on this workshop to understand and to try to find solutions.

Andrew Cutting is the National Autistic Society lead on Reducing Exclusions in our schools. In the morning - Andrew will be running a workshop in conjunction with the Autism Outreach Service for parents to offer advice, support, ideas and understand some of the issues (there will not be time for individual clinic discussions) and then in the afternoon Andrew and AOS will be meeting with representatives from schools to offer advice, support, ideas and understand some of the issues from the schools.
