

NOTES:

## **GENERAL**

- 1. All dimensions are in millimetres unless otherwise stated.
- This type of fencing is not intended for accommodation works applications but for protective fencing alongside cycleways where steep embankments or other dangers are present.
- Where the fence is erected alongside a cycleway, the rails should be nailed on the cycleway side of the posts and set back 500mm from the edge of the cycleway.
- 4. Fencing to follow the ground profile with small adjustments to height as necessary to obtain flowing alignment.

## **MATERIALS**

- All timber shall comply with 'Specification for Highway Works — 6th Edition' Clause 304 and CCA preservation to BS4072.
- 2. Nails shall be 4mm x 100mm galvanised in accordance with the requirements of BS729.
