

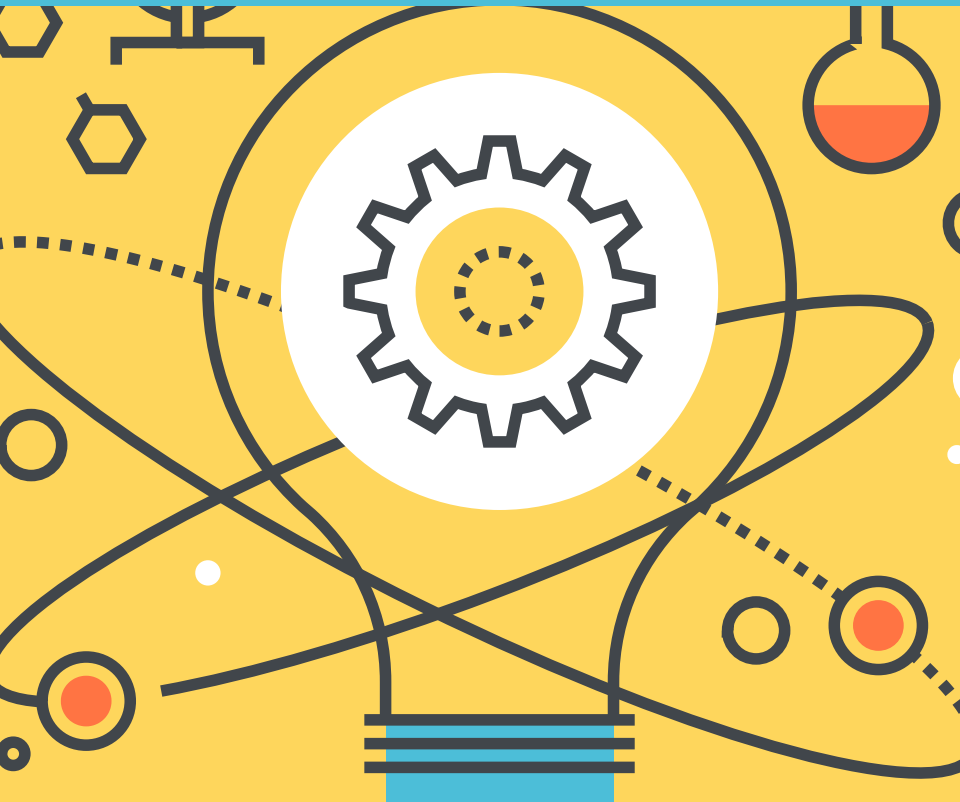

# Thinking of what to do for British Science Week 2020 & thereafter?

**EVER SINCE THE ADVENT OF MEDICINE, PLANTS & HUMANS HAVE BEEN INEXTRICABLY LINKED. DURING THIS SESSION THE PUPILS WILL LEARN ABOUT HOW THE AGE OF ENLIGHTENMENT CHANGED OUR VIEW ON HOW WE SEE PLANTS & HOW THEY AFFECT US.**
