Girls with autism are often overlooked for support because their identifying behaviours can be different to that of boys. Without a diagnosis of autism, girls on the autism spectrum can struggle with extreme

stress, leading to mental health issues, problem behaviours, school refusal or other outcomes which impact on adult lives
