

## **New opportunities for Key stage 1 and Key stage 2 Pool Moderators**

We are looking for enthusiastic and respected teachers to add to our established moderation teams.

You will have qualified teacher status, a minimum of two years qualified teaching experience including current teaching in Year 2 or Year 6 alongside moderation in a variety of contexts. Your wider experience of moderation should include moderation across school or schools which has enabled you to build a wide understanding of the moderation process. You will have a strong knowledge of the issues around moderation and the ability to learn and adapt quickly. Crucially you will need to have the interpersonal skills which will allow you to communicate effectively both orally and in writing with head teachers and senior leaders in schools and academies. You will be expected to work closely with our Lead Moderators at Key stage 1 / 2 as well as the local authority Leads for Key stage 1 or Key stage 2. You will need to be able to demonstrate tact, diplomacy and the ability to recognise the sometimes confidential aspects of the work you do on behalf of Leicestershire. The role will require you to contribute to work as part of a team as well as contributing to the delivery of training for teachers and senior leaders. Each year the STA set a standardisation task for pool moderators and as part of your continued professional development in the role you will need to be successful in this activity.

If you feel that you have qualifications, experience and interpersonal skills that would make you the right candidate for one of these roles we would like to hear from you.

Applications should be made using no more than one side of A4 outlining your experience, skills and reasons you feel you are the right candidate. You will also be required to supply a letter from your current Headteacher outlining their support for your application.
