This is an unannounced inspection and could be called as early as Monday 13 January.

During the first week, Inspectors will be reviewing all of our data, our self-evaluation and key strategies and policies. The following week, inspectors will arrive on site.

I'd also like to particularly highlight our strengths and areas for development which are summarised on the attached PDF. This might be a useful document to share within your organisation. Inspectors will be checking our understanding of this when they're here.

I am urging staff within the council to speak with passion and ambition about our children and young people and I hope you'll join me in doing the same as we welcome the inspectors.
